- Coaches, officials, and designated volunteers should conduct safety checks before each practice or game.
- The checklist covers various aspects of field and facility safety, including goal post safety, field and area safety, and other specific concerns for individual fields.
- It includes items like ensuring the proper anchoring of goal posts, inspecting goal nets and posts for hazards, and checking for foreign objects, holes, and torn sections on the field.
- Other safety considerations include maintaining a safe distance from the touchline, reviewing fencing, inspecting bleachers and players' benches, checking the condition of locker rooms, restrooms, and portable toilets, and surveying parking lots, concessions, and vendor areas for hazards.
- It emphasizes notifying the club of unsafe conditions in writing and making spectators and players aware of any hazardous conditions.
